

6-4B-6: GOLF CARTS:

Except as otherwise permitted by law, no golf cart shall be operated on any village street, except to make a direct crossing under the following conditions:

- A. The crossing is made at an interchange approved by the village and at a place where no obstruction prevents a quick and safe crossing; and

- B. The golf cart is brought to a complete stop before attempting a crossing; and

- C. The operator of the golf cart yields the right of way to all pedestrian and vehicular traffic that constitutes a hazard; and

- D. There is no tunnel or overpass ramp provided for the golf cart to cross through the golf course. (Ord. 2005-02-333, 2-7-2005)
