

11-1428: OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS:

- (a) Any terms not otherwise defined in this section shall have the meaning as set forth in the Illinois vehicle code. For purposes of this section "golf cart" means a vehicle specifically designed and intended for the purposes of transporting one or more persons and their golf clubs or maintenance equipment while engaged in the playing of golf, supervising the play of golf, or maintaining the condition of the grounds on a public or private golf course.

- (b) Subject to the terms hereof, it shall not be a violation of village ordinances for any person who is a licensed driver to drive or operate a golf cart upon the golf cart pathway extending approximately two hundred sixty feet (260') from the intersection of Wynstone Drive and Del Webb Boulevard north along the east side of Wynstone Drive to its intersection with Blue Stem Drive and there crossing Wynstone Drive in the designated golf cart crossing.

- (c) The operation of a golf cart on the roadways herein described, including operation of a golf cart after sunset and before sunrise, shall be in compliance with the provisions of the Illinois rules of the road and the Illinois vehicle code.

- (d) The village of Shorewood, Illinois, shall post appropriate signs designating the golf cart crossing as described above.

- (e) The provisions contained herein shall be enforced in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Illinois rules of the road and the Illinois vehicle code⁸, as may be amended from time to time. (Ord. 05-1268, 1-11-2005)
