Golf Cart Regulations

Within the City Limits of Pana

1. All golf carts operating within the City or City Lake Property must obtain a registration sticker with the Pana Police Department and are bound by the City of Pana Ordinance pertaining to golf carts. (Ordinance #1677)
2. All golf carts must have a firmly attach and visible City of Pana Golf Cart registration sticker attached to rear portion of vehicle.
3. No person shall operate the vehicle unless 21 years of age or older with a valid drivers license.
4. Liability insurance coverage is required on vehicle to operate on city streets and to provide proof upon request by Law Enforcement.
5. The following equipment is mandatory and properly functioning on each vehicle:
 - a. Brakes, Steering apparatus, Tires
 - b. Rear view mirror
 - c. Red reflective warning devices on front and rear
 - d. Manufactured vehicle specific head and tail lights with required visibility distances listed in ordinance, and activated at all times
 - e. Turn signals and break lights
6. Daylight hours of operation only between sunrise and sunset
7. Golf carts are only allowed on streets where the posted speed limit is 30 mph or less; unless otherwise prohibited by local government.
8. Golf Carts are not allowed to operate on any state highways within the City limits of Pana (IL Route 16, 29, and 51) unless entering or exiting the driveway of the registered owner's residence.
9. Golf Cart Operators can only cross State Highways at the following intersections:
 - a. Washington and Sheridan
 - b. Washington and State
 - c. Washington and Locust
 - d. First and Vine
 - e. Second and John/Sherman
 - f. Second and State
 - g. Second and Walnut
 - h. Second and Locust
 - i. Jackson and Pine
 - j. Poplar and Third
 - k. Poplar and Fourth
 - l. Fair Ave and Ninth

Law Enforcement personnel will aggressively enforce the above listed regulations in an attempt to obtain the highest level of public safety for the citizens of our community. Please refer to the entire reading of the City Ordinance for Golf Carts.
